APPRENTICE REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR 2010 FALL CLASSES

ABC - Florida Gulf Coast Chapter is among the leading education and training institutions within ABC nationally. It is recognized for its quality apprenticeship training programs throughout the education community in Florida. Utilizing the state of the art classroom and laboratory facilities at HCC, students have the opportunity to "Earn While They Learn" and generate college credits. The entire scope of education and training services provided by ABC is available to meet your company's specific needs.

For your perusal, a brief description of the various programs now available is given below. More detailed information is available on request which ABC staff specialists will be glad to prepare and deliver.

Apprenticeship Training Programs utilize the standardized "ConTren Learning Series" curriculum, which includes classroom instruction from certified instructors as well as hands-on lab experience.

- **Carpentry** - Erects framework in buildings, including sub-flooring, sheathing, partitions, floor joists, studding and rafters, install molding, wood paneling, cabinets, window sashes, doorframes, doors and hardware. Build concrete forms for decks, columns, piers and retaining walls, as well as installing heavy timber for docks. Erect scaffolding and temporary buildings.
- **Electrical** - Lay out, assemble, install and test electrical fixtures and apparatus and wiring used in electrical systems. Install and connect electrical machinery, electronic equipment, controls and signal and communication systems.
- **HVAC (Refrigeration, Heating & Air Conditioning)** - Install and maintain the piping equipment and controls used in refrigeration, heating and cooling systems.
- **Plumbing** - Install pipe systems that carry water, steam, air or other liquids or gases needed for sanitation, industrial production or other uses. Alter and repair existing pipe systems and install plumbing fixtures, appliances and heating and refrigeration units.
- **Sheet Metal** - Fabricate and install ducts used in ventilating, air-conditioning and heating systems. Fabricates and installs metal roofing, guttering and siding, partitions, store fronts, etc.
- **Sprinkler Fitter (Fire Sprinklers)** - Install piping equipment for fire protection systems both underground into a structure and in the structure itself. Work with valves and pumps that are a part of the automatic sprinkler system.
